



## Women's Ohio State Golf Association

Policy No: 2016-02, CARTS

Purpose: To establish the policy for use of carts during events by players, caddies, spectators, and other participants or attendees

---

Carts are permitted at the WOSGA State Amateur Invitational and State Senior Invitational Championships, unless otherwise noted, and may be included in the entry fee for a selection of WOSGA championships. A limit of 2 carts per group will be enforced.

Caddies may ride with players as long as caddies do not take the seat of another player. If a player and their caddie wish to ride alone, they may do so with permission of the host club as long as they do not exceed the 2 cart per group rule. Note the definition of caddie and equipment when using carts.

A fee is required for all seats in a cart. If a caddie and a player choose to ride, a fee is required for the additional seat in the cart.

If the State Amateur club's hosting agreement requires that all players use carts, players may still walk and/or use a caddie; however, they will be required to pay cart fees regardless of whether they used the cart. All players in the State Senior must ride in carts.

All drivers must have a valid driver's license. All players, both walkers and riders, are required to maintain the pace set for the competition.

If spectators wish to ride in a cart, they may do so at all WOSGA events, including the Ohio Junior Girls, at the host course's discretion. The hosting course may charge spectators a fee to ride in carts.
